

D17 Grant Program

The D17 Grant Program is provided to support beginner education and membership building. All D17 units are eligible to apply. The maximum grant award for a project will be \$1000. Smaller amounts may be awarded.

The grant request form should be completed and submitted to the Grant Chair, who will present it to the board for consideration. It is the goal of the board to respond to grant requests as soon as possible. A vote will be taken at the board meeting following the final processing of information presented. Applicants will be notified of decisions through email.

A Unit may sponsor an individual teacher or volunteer. The financial situation of the Unit will be taken into consideration during the decision making process. If the Unit is strong financially they may consider sponsoring the project locally or co-sponsoring with the District.

Please do not apply for a grant for projects that have been completed. Plan ahead and apply for projects in the future. If you have applied for a grant in the past, please note that another application will not be considered until two years have elapsed since the last grant was awarded to the same unit.
